

I know a lot of you will now be at home and we want to make sure those brains of yours are kept busy during this time. I present to you, the **Little Inventors Daily Challenge!**







1 Open the box




2 Stick together here

6 Poke straws through holes




5 Two straws




8 Draw something from the Future

Follow these instructions to make your future viewing binoculars! What will you see?








