

I challenge you!


I know a lot of you will now be at home and we want to make sure those brains of yours are kept busy during this time. I present to you, the **Little Inventors Daily Challenge!**


1. On a blank piece of paper draw a circle. Its radius should be at least the length of your index finger. To do that use a compass or trace around an object (e.g. a bowl, a cup, a pot).




2. Cut out the circle and fold it in half twice until you get a quarter.



3. Draw a body of a chosen character on each piece. It can be an animal, a princess, an alien, whatever you like!




4. Cut out the corner of the quarter and unfold your circle. Cut along the folds to get 4 pieces for 4 different finger puppets.



6. Draw a head of your character and cut it out. You can also draw a tail or an accessory. Attach the head to your cone with glue.



5. Fit the cone snugly around your finger and join the edges with glue.






DESIGN A BOOK FOR SOMEONE TO




STEP 1.




